INVITATION TO WORSHIP

One: Sing praise to God, all the peoples!

All: Praise God who really loves us all!

One: Don't be afraid and do not doubt God's love.

All: Open our hearts, O God, and help us to receive that love.

One: Dance in joy to the spirit of God.

All: Let our spirits resound with joy at God's light of joy.

In the midst of our fear, remind us of your transforming and overflowing love and the jars of plenty out of which we can live abundantly in service to all people, especially those who are struggling in body, mind, and spirit. Amen.
