Take three deep and centering breaths.


Breathe in "Loving God"

INVITATION TO WORSHIP

One: Run from fear and darkness! Hope is on the move!

All: Run to tell the world, Christ is risen!

One: Do not be afraid. Jesus has conquered death!

All: We can proclaim with great confidence that God's love rules.

One: Christ is risen!

All: Christ is risen indeed!

Pastor: We have journeyed for several weeks reminding ourselves that life and the world is full of awe. We have seen beauty, we have opened to wonder, we have searched for meaning with curiosity, we have delighted in the gifts of the Divine One. We have reconnected with each other and remembered the joy of self-giving on behalf of a better world. This morning is the most awe-filled of all. Our faith story is ultimately about the victory of life over death.

All: With awe, we accept God's belovedness. Thanks be to God!

SCRIPTURE READING: Mark 16:1-8

MESSAGE: "Awe" Rev. Grace Suwabe

On this Easter morning as we consider the empty tomb, we should be in awe of the massive implications of the resurrection, which stirs in our souls a deep sense of amazement and wonder and an indestructible sense of hope. Jesus is alive, gives eternal life to all who believe in Him, and has given us resurrection life right now. (Please contemplate on these words and spend some time with God in prayer.)
